Faith Comes By Hearing: "A Prescription of Justice" (Isaiah 1:1-20)

So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ. - Romans 10:17 ESV

Warm up: Read Jesus's "Parable of the Unforgiving Servant" in Matthew 18:23-34.

\*Why do you think the "other servants" (v.31) are so upset about what happened?

\*How have you experienced injustice? How have you caused it? Exposed/fought it?

Read: <u>Isaiah 1:1-20</u>

1. THE SYMPTOMS (Isaiah 1:5-9, 11-15)

- **a) People:** The whole head is hurt, and the whole heart is sick. (v.5)
  - $\rightarrow$  See Genesis 12:1-3

### **EFCA Statement of Faith**

  - **b) Place:** Your land is desolate, your cities burned down. (v.7)
    - → See Deuteronomy 29:22-29
  - c) Presence: When you spread out your hands in prayer... Your hands are covered with blood. (v.15)
    - → See Amos 5:21-24, Micah 6:6-8

#### 4 Words, 1 Problem:

Rebelled ... Abandoned ... Despised ... Turned =

"... apart from me you can do nothing." - Jesus (John 15:5 ESV)
